There is lots of binkies, though they still try to get under the couch which has been blocked off with a fence. Now their main adversary appears to be my robot vacuum which they have been jumping on and off constantly. This is just week one of many more to come!"

## Pocky Finds His Perfect Match

Pocky originally came into our care through our Facilitation Adoption program in August 2022. After 3 weeks he was returned, and then was adopted and returned two more times in 2022 due to behavioural concerns.

After his third return, Pocky was placed under Behavioural Care and went into a foster home so that the training staff could better understand his behaviours in a home environment. Pocky struggled with resource guarding and through positive reinforcement training he started to improve.

On May 10th, 2023, Pocky found his perfect match. He now goes by Toby and his new family absolutely adores him and describes him as calm and well-mannered.
