

Spay/Neuter Fee Guide and FAQ's

What is included in a surgical package?

- Presurgical examination with a veterinarian
- Day hospitalization (we do not provide overnight care)
- Surgical procedure
- Anesthesia and anesthetic medications
- Postoperative pain medication
- Recheck exam for evaluation of complications related to surgery (to be determined by a veterinarian)

What is NOT included in a surgical package? *These items are invoiced separately.*

- Additional medication such as anti-nausea medications or antibiotics
- E-collar
- Vaccinations
- Microchip
- Additional medications (if prescribed) at time of recheck exam.

What is a 'high-volume' procedure?

Our high-volume procedures are for young, healthy cats and dogs who meet all our [surgical eligibility criteria](#). They are patients who do not have any conditions that would increase their risk of surgical or anesthetic complications. Your pet will receive an examination with a veterinarian the morning of surgery to confirm that they qualify as a high-volume surgery. If concerns arise during the examination, we reserve the right to change the surgical level or reschedule your surgery to another day depending on the situation.

What is an 'extended time' procedure?

Extended surgical or anesthetic procedures may be necessary for pets that need additional treatments outside of our standard surgical protocols. This may be due to higher surgical or anesthetic risk levels or a longer procedure time. Our team will assess whether your pet requires an extended procedure at the time of booking your appointment, but the most appropriate package may be determined by the veterinarian at the time of your pet's pre-surgical health exam. Examples of pets where an 'Extended Time' package would apply:

- Cryptorchid males (one or both testicles undescended)
- Brachycephalic breeds
- Hernia repairs
- Pets with heart murmurs
- Pets with underlying health conditions
- Senior pets (>7 years of age)
- Pregnant or recently post-partum females
- Obese patients
- Canine patients that are greater than 40 kg (88 lbs)



Additionally, our veterinarians may recommend a pre-surgical consult to determine the appropriate procedure type (High Volume or Extended Time Procedure) for your pet's specific needs. Please note that there may be additional fees for administering intravenous fluids or other necessary treatments. **Please note that we only have availability for 1-2 'extended time' procedures daily and a longer wait time for these appointments should be anticipated.**

Subsidized pricing is available to individuals with proof of one of the following:

- Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP)
- Ontario Works (OW)
- Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)
- Canada Pension Plan Disability (CPP-D)

Proof of receipt of one of these programs must be provided at the time of each visit to the clinic and must be registered to the pet owner. For ODSP, OW, GIS, or CPP-D, we require a document that shows your name, what benefit is received, and the most recent statement date. This can be in hardcopy or through the MyBenefits app. For GIS and CPP-D, this is generally a document from the CRA.

To uphold the integrity of our subsidized pricing initiative for First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples and ensure that it benefits those within Indigenous communities, we request documentation to verify Indigenous identity.

We accept the following forms of documentation:

- Certificate of Indian Status (Status Card)
- Nunavut Trust Certificate card or Inuit Enrollment card
- Métis Nation citizenship or membership card
- Citizenship card/letter issued by a First Nation with a modern Treaty and/or self-government agreement.
- Other acceptable documentation such as alternative membership cards or letters from Indigenous communities or organizations, providing attestation to the individual's Indigenous identity.

What forms of payment do you accept?

We accept cash, debit, or credit (Visa, Mastercard, American Express). We do not accept personal cheques.

Do you offer payment plans?

Unfortunately, we are not able to offer delayed billing or payment plans. Surgical fees must be paid in full at the time of dropping your pet off for surgery.

Is there HST (tax) on the surgical fees?

No, as we are a registered charity, we do not charge HST.
